Poster & Poster Video Content Requirements

Target Population: Must be about or applicable to rural and medically underserved Arizona communities.

Accepted Topics: Behavioral Health Integration; Border Health; Connecting Communities and Supporting Health Professionals; Cultural Competency; Current and Emerging Health Issues; Diversity; Interprofessional Education and Practice; Native American Health; Practice Transformation; Rural Health; Social Determinants of Health; Underserved Populations; and Virtual Learning and Telehealth.

The RHPP Conference Planning Committee reserves the right to not accept poster/poster videos if topics are not relevant to serving rural and medically underserved communities of Arizona.

| Formatting Requirements | <ul style="list-style-type: none">Posters may not be larger than 48” (height) x 72” (length).PDF format accepted only. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><u>Video presentations should be limited to 3 minutes.</u> Videos that exceed three minutes will be stopped at the three-minute mark.<ul style="list-style-type: none">Video audio must remain at normal speed and not be sped up to meet the time limit.Videos must include written closed captions that accurately reflect the presenter’s spoken audio.<i>Helpful Tip:</i> When developing your video, consider how participants will be viewing your poster. As an example, you may want to zoom in on areas of your poster as you are discussing it. |

- Poster viewing will begin one week prior to the start of the conference and will be available on our [website](#).
- The virtual Conference Poster Showcase will be held on the afternoon of Friday, April 10, 2026, from approximately 2:00-6:30pm; actual times will be published on the agenda (when available).**
 - Video presentations of posters will be shown during the showcase, followed by a moderated Q & A session.
*Video poster presentations will only be shown during the Showcase if the presenters are online for the showcase.
 - Submitted PDF posters will be available for viewing on the AzAHEC website only.

Poster Awards

- Awards will be given for Outstanding and Excellent posters and Excellence in Video Presentation.
- Awards will be shared equally among all listed authors and co-authors, exclusive of faculty.
- Posters are scored according to the following categories: relevance, quality of research, quality of written information, and quality of graphic presentation.
- Videos are scored according to the following categories: effective use of technology, quality of presentation, effective communication, and innovation.
- Awards will be announced during the main conference session on Saturday, April 11th at a time specified on the agenda.

Posters are accepted upon submission. You will be contacted regarding your poster only if additional information is required or it is not accepted.
